District Information

Lowell Rural Fire Protection District covers 23 square miles and operates two fire stations and one training station. The

main station is located at 389 N Pioneer Street, Lowell, and a substation at 39605 Little Fall Creek, Fall Creek. The district is staffed by a paid Chief, Deputy Chief, Captain and Lieutenant as well as 20 volunteer responders.

The district trains its firefighters in fire suppression, motor vehicle extrication, low angle rope rescue, water rescue, medical response and hazardous materials response at the operational level.

Resident Firefighter/EMT

Students will work on assigned shifts with career staff as they gain experience running emergent calls for service.

Residents are expected to attend regularly scheduled shifts and trainings. Absences from scheduled shifts are excused while attending classes within their program.

Minimum Qualifications:

Valid driver's license with a clean record.

- Successfully pass a criminal background and medical physical.
- Pass the district physical agility.

Desired Qualifications:

- Firefighter 1 certification
- NFPA Driver
- EMR or higher

Student benefits include:

- AFLAC after 6 months.
- Employee Assistance Program.
- Kitchen, laundry facilities and weight room use.
- Free use of utilities including TV and Internet access.
- Hands on Training in Firefighting, Rescue and EMS
- Rent free living in individual room, with common day room.
